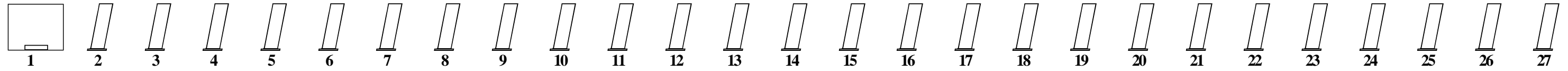


DIRECTIONS FOR VOTING ON THE AUTOMATIC VOTING MACHINE

- 1st. Move the red handle to the right and leave it there.
- 2nd. Turn the pointer from this position to this position over the names of the candidates you wish to vote for.
- 3rd. Turn a pointer over the **YES** or **NO** of the question or proposition.
- 4th. Leave the pointers down .
- 5th. To vote for a person whose name does not appear on the machine, lift up the slot in the column above the title of the office and write or stamp in the name.
- 6th. Move the red handle to the left in order to register your vote and exit machine.



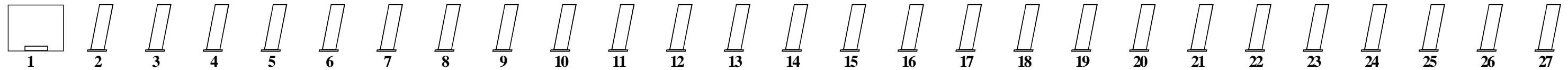

| <p>YES NO</p> <p style="text-align: center;">PROPOSAL ONE, AN AMENDMENT</p> <p>Amendment to section 11 of article 14 of the Constitution, in relation to the use of certain forest preserve lands by National Grid to construct a 46 kV power line along State Route 56 in St. Lawrence County.</p> <p>The proposed amendment would authorize the Legislature to convey up to six acres of forest preserve land along State Route 56 in St. Lawrence County to National Grid for construction of a power line. In exchange, National Grid would convey to the State at least 10 acres of forest land in St. Lawrence County, to be incorporated into the forest preserve. The land to be conveyed by National Grid to the State must be at least equal in value to the land conveyed to National Grid by the State. Shall the proposed amendment be approved?</p> | <p>YES NO</p> <p style="text-align: center;">PROPOSAL TWO, AN AMENDMENT</p> <p>Amendment to article 3 of the Constitution, in relation to authorizing the Legislature to allow prisoners to voluntarily perform work for nonprofit organizations.</p> <p>The proposed amendment would authorize the Legislature to pass legislation to permit inmates in state and local correctional facilities to perform work for nonprofit organizations. Shall the proposed amendment be approved?</p> |
